



Thank you for choosing Memorial Healthcare for your Healthcare needs. Attached is a copy of our Financial Assistance Application.

Helpful information in completing the Financial Assistance Form:

1. Patient must live within the Hospital service area (generally defined as Shiawassee County, Ovid/Elsie and Chesaning).
2. If the patient is over 18 years of age and resides with another adult that is not their spouse we will only need the patient's information.
3. If patient is receiving care for services related to Cancer diagnosis or as an Inpatient a **Medicaid application** must be filed before qualifying for any assistance through the Hospital.
4. If patient is under 19 years old they must apply for MICHILD or MEDICAID before qualifying for any help through the Hospital.
5. A copy of the most recent tax return filed must be submitted.
6. This application will only apply to services billed by Memorial Healthcare or Memorial Medical Associates.
7. Patients may incur charges for other physicians such as Emergency Physicians, Radiologist, Cardiologist, Pulmonologist, Pathologist, Anesthesiologist, etc. when being seen at the Hospital. You may receive bills for services from physicians that you did not see; for example; a Radiologist for reading an x-ray film. Please call the number on the bill you receive from them for help.
8. If you are receiving Disability or Unemployment send proof of monthly payment.
9. All information must be completed and returned back that is listed on the Financial Assistance Application. Incomplete forms will be returned back to you and cause a delay in review of your application.
10. If there is a self pay balance after Financial Assistance is granted, a payment plan will be offered through CarePayment for the remaining balance of the account.
