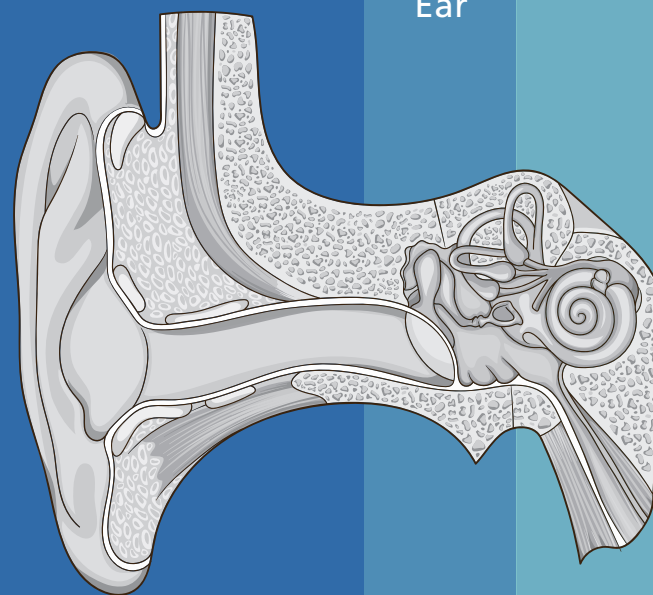


## Sections of the EAR

## TYPES of Hearing Loss

### COMMON CAUSES OF HEARING LOSS

*Loud concerts, earbuds with music too high, exposure to workplace hearing hazards, etc.*

### CONDUCTIVE

Sound is not conducted efficiently through the outer ear canal to the eardrum. Usually involves a reduction in sound level, and the inability to hear faint sounds.

### SENSORINEURAL

There is damage to the inner ear or nerve pathways.

### MIXED

A combination of Conductive and Sensorineural hearing loss, where damage may be in the outer or middle ear and the inner ear or auditory nerve.
