



## VISITATION POLICY

EFFECTIVE MAY 22, 2023

**Memorial Healthcare continues to follow the highest safety standards to protect the health of our communities due to the COVID-19 pandemic. As we are currently at our lowest COVID-19 risk level, we have reopened visitation to our patients.**

**Our commitment to health and safety remains our highest priority. We continue to monitor the risk of COVID-19 and will adjust visitor restrictions as necessary. If you have any question, please contact (989) 720-CARE prior to visitation. We appreciate your help in keeping our patients and employees safe.**

### **ALL INPATIENT UNITS:**

- **Visitation hours are 9:00 am to 9:00 pm daily.**
- **Our main entrance closes at 7:00 pm daily. If you are visiting after 7:00 pm, please use our Emergency Department entrance.**
- **Patients can have multiple healthy visitors (over the age of 12) and can visit two at a time.**
- **Those who are approved to enter will be expected to:**
  - Enter through the main lobby (after 7:00 pm, please enter through the Emergency Department)
  - Be screened for signs of illness
  - Must wear a mask if any signs of respiratory illness
  - Stay at the patient's bedside and not wander the hallways
  - Sanitize/wash hands every time entering or leaving a patient's room
  - Not gather in common areas such as waiting rooms or lobbies
- **Visitors will be asked to return home if they do not comply with Memorial Healthcare's visitation policy.**
- **Visitors for patients who are COVID-19 positive or are suspected of COVID-19 will be approved on a case-by-case basis by medical staff.**
